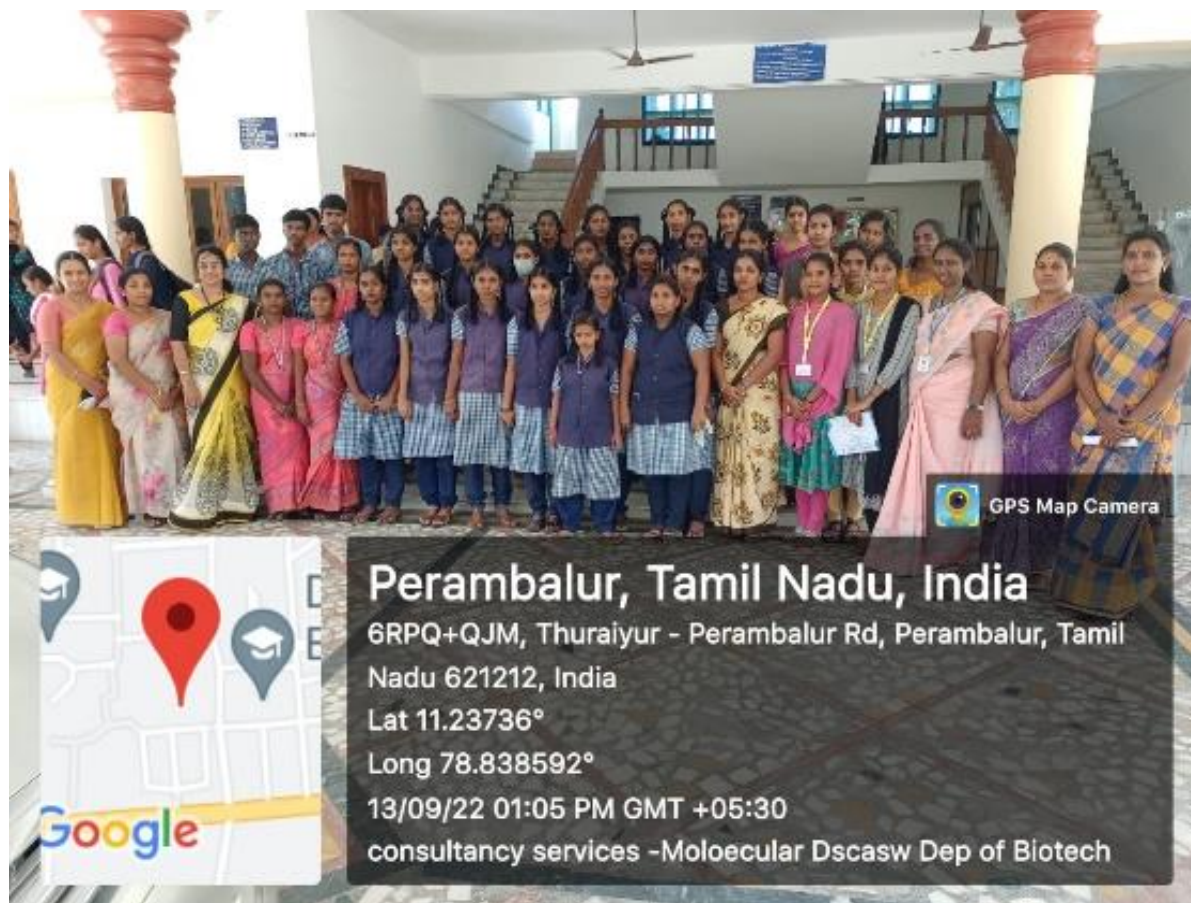
### 3. Medical coding
